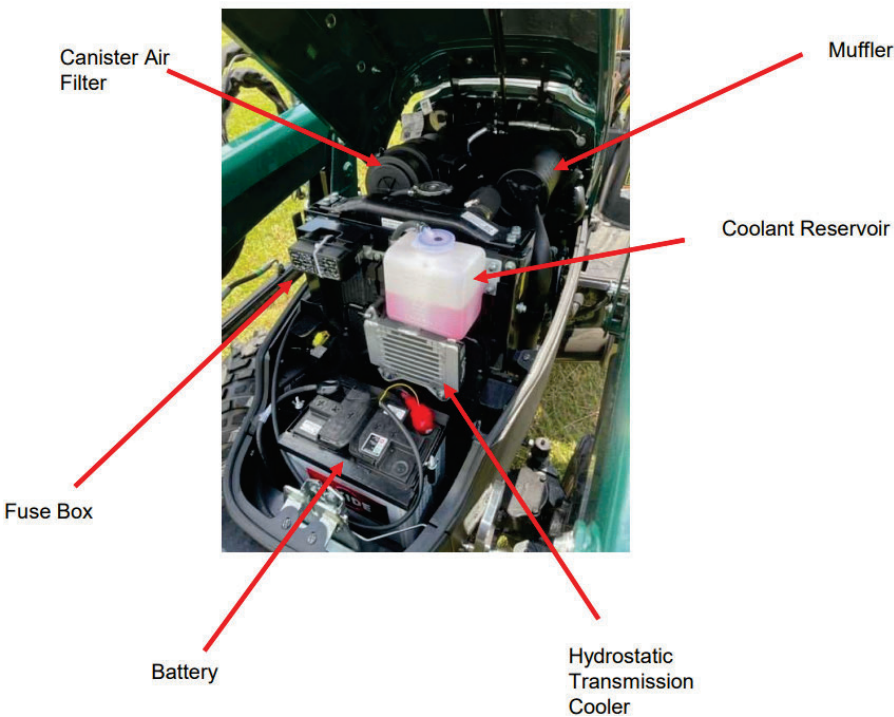

Starting & Operating the Tractor

- Sit in tractor seat to activate operator presence switch
- Seatbelt fastened
- Rollover Protection Structure in Up Position
- H-N-L Transmission Range Set to “N” (neutral)
- Foot on brake pedal – left foot
- Turn the key to start
- Pull the loader joystick back to raise loader bucket, forward to lower the bucket
- Move transmission range selector to “L” (low)
- Release parking brake (golf ball shaped knob – pull out and down to release, pull out and up to set)
- Release foot brake
- Use the forward/reverse pedals by the right foot for direction
- Hand throttle is located right side of steering wheel – forward increases, backward decreases RPM. Be aware that the loader bucket extends three feet in front of hood
- When completed with movement, lower the loader to the ground
- Turn off tractor
- Set parking brake
- Keep transmission range selector in “L” or “H” when parked
- Slow and easy does it!

3rd Function Hydraulic Diverter Valve & Loader Lowering Speed Control

- **3rd Function:** The Summit LX85 Loader comes standard with a 3rd function hydraulics diverter valve
- When pressing the button on the front side at top of the loader joystick, the loader function switches from dump/curl (joystick side-to-side movement) to the 3rd function
- Typically used to open and closes the jaws of a grapple or changes the angle of a hydraulic front blade
- **Loader Drop Control:** You can control the speed of loader lowering by using the flow rate control valve
- The lever is located at the loader connections block on the right side of the tractor

LIMITED WARRANTY FOR NEW SUMMIT TRACTORS AND SUMMIT FRONT-END LOADERS

A. GENERAL PROVISIONS: The warranties described below are provided by Summit Tractors LLC ("Summit") to the original purchasers of new SUMMIT brand tractors and front-end loaders ("Equipment") from any SUMMIT retail store location. Under the warranties provided by SUMMIT, SUMMIT will repair or replace, at its option, any covered part which is found to be defective in material or workmanship during the applicable warranty term. Warranty service must be performed at a service center authorized by SUMMIT to service the type of Equipment involved, which will use only new or remanufactured parts or components furnished or sourced by SUMMIT. Warranty service will be performed without charge to the purchaser for parts and labor. The purchaser will be responsible, however, for any service call and/or transportation of any Equipment or Product to and from the service center's place of business, and for any service and/or maintenance not directly related to any defect covered under the warranties below. These warranties are transferable provided an authorized SUMMIT service center is notified of the ownership change, and SUMMIT approves the transfer. SUMMIT reserves the right to make alterations or modifications in its equipment at any time, which in its opinion may improve the performance and efficiency of the Product. SUMMIT shall not be obliged to make such alterations to products which have been shipped or are in service.

B. WHAT IS WARRANTED: Subject to the Length of Warranty Chart below, as amended from time to time, acknowledging limitations on the term of warranty, all parts of any new SUMMIT Equipment, except tires and wheels and batteries (which are warranted by the manufacturer of each product), are warranted for the number of months or operating hours specified below. Warranty statements required by law covering engine emission-related parts and components, which shall not be less than the engine warranty, are found in the operator's manual delivered with the equipment. Included in the Summit Tractors Powertrain Warranty - Engine: cylinder block, cylinder head, valve covers, oil pan, timing gear covers, flywheel housing, emission control components and all parts contained therein. Powertrain: Transmission, transmission case, differential and axle housing, MFWD front axle assembly, and all parts contained therein. The Powertrain Warranty does not include external drivelines, or steering cylinders including but not limited to the HST assembly (HST pump), HST damper plate, and the HST damper assembly.

C. WHAT IS NOT WARRANTED - SUMMIT IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FOLLOWING: (1) Used equipment; (2) Any Equipment that has been altered or modified in ways not approved by SUMMIT, including but not limited to setting injection pump fuel delivery above SUMMIT or manufacturer specifications; (3) Depreciation or damage caused by normal wear and tear, lack of reasonable or proper maintenance, failure to follow operating instructions, misuse, lack of proper protection during storage, or accident; (4) Normal maintenance parts and service including, but not limited to, light bulbs, filters (oil, fuel, air and hydraulic), belts, motor brushes, brakes, fuses and switches, clutch linings, engine tune-up, wheel alignment, blade sharpening and lubrication. All existing warranties, including IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, TO THE EXTENT APPLICABLE, SHALL BE LIMITED IN DURATION TO THE APPLICABLE PERIOD OF WARRANTY SET FORTH HEREIN. Unless otherwise prohibited by law, THE PURCHASER'S ONLY REMEDIES IN CONNECTION WITH THE BREACH OR PERFORMANCE OF ANY WARRANTY OF THE EQUIPMENT ARE THOSE SET FORTH HEREIN. IN NO EVENT WILL THE SERVICE CENTER, SUMMIT OR ANY SUMMIT AFFILIATE OR AGENT THEREOF BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, LOSS OF REVENUE, LOSS OF USE, LOAN PAYMENTS, COST OF RENTAL OR SUBSTITUTE EQUIPMENT, INSURANCE COVERAGE, STORAGE, LODGING, TRANSPORTATION, FUEL, MILEAGE AND COMMUNICATION COSTS).
